We call for articles to the professional scientific journal "Innovative Pedagogy"

Issue 72, 2024

Innovative Pedagogy is a periodical scientific journal, which was founded in 2017 by the Black Sea Research Institute of Economy and Innovation.

Based on the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated 14.05.2020 № 627 (Annex

2) the journal is included in the List of professional editions of Ukraine (category "B") in the area of pedagogical sciences (011 – Educational pedagogical sciences, 012 – Preschool education, 013 – Primary education, 014 – Secondary education, 015 – Vocational education (by specialties), 016 – Special education).

Innovative Pedagogy aims to cover the results of pedagogy research, introduce modern scientific and pedagogical developments, come into line with the latest developments in modern pedagogical practice.

Sections of the scientific journal:

1. General pedagogy and history of pedagogy.
2. Theory and methodology of teaching (subject area).
3. Correctional pedagogy.
4. Theory and methodology of professional education.
5. Social pedagogy.
6. Theory and methodology of educational management.
7. Theory and methodology of education.
8. Preschool pedagogy.
9. Learning theory.
10. Information and communication technologies in education.

To publish an article in the scientific journal **Issue 72/2024**, you should:

1. fill in a form about the author [by the link](#) or by QR_code
2. send the article designed according to the requirements to editor@innovpedagogy.od.ua before **June 28, 2024**.



Academic integrity

The editorial board of the journal carries out an external and internal review of all received articles. The peer review takes at least two days.

The articles are checked for plagiarism using the software [StrikePlagiarism.com](https://www.strikeplagiarism.com) developed by the Polish company [Plagiat.pl](https://www.plagiat.pl).

The editorial office awards each published manuscript with **DOI** (digital object identifier).

After approval of the article by the editorial board, the author receives payment details of the publication fee.

A scanned copy of payment confirmation of publication fee should be sent to e-mail of the editorial office.

The publication cost is **1400 UAH** (up to 10 pages inclusive). Each additional page is paid individually – 40 UAH.

The publication fee covers the costs associated with review, proofreading and editing of articles, layout of the collection and placement of its electronic version.

The electronic version of the journal is timely placed in public access on the publication's website.

If desired, the author of the article can order a printed copy of the magazine. The cost of a **printed copy** is **UAH 800**, which must be paid in addition to the publication fee.

The electronic version of the magazine will be posted on the website until September 30, 2024.

The printed version of the journal will be sent to authors of articles who order a printed copy by October 31, 2024.

A scientific article must include the following essential elements:

Problem statement in general form and its relation to important scientific or practical tasks.

An analysis of recent research and publications, which deal with a problem and approaches to its solution, the author relies on. Moreover, it is necessary to highlight the unresolved parts of the common problem that is under the article's consideration.

Emphasizing previously unresolved parts of the common problem.

Formulation of the article's goals (tasks statement)

Presentation of the basic research material with full justification of findings.

Conclusions from the study and further **prospects in the research area.**

Summaries and keywords are in Ukrainian and English, as well as translation of the article title into English (summary volume - minimum 1800 characters, keywords - minimum 5 words); the UDC index (in the upper left corner of the page); journal section; surname and initials of author (s), academic degree, academic rank, place of employment / study.

References. References to the sources should be made in square brackets, indicating the page numbers according to the source: for example, [3, p. 234] or [2, p. 35; 8, p. 234].

Languages: Ukrainian, English.

Prohibition of using scientific works of the occupying country

It is prohibited citing and including in the reference list russian-language contributions published in any country, incl. papers written in other languages but published in russia and belarus.

Technical requirements:

1. Article volume – from 10 to 20 pages, A4 (297 x 210), margins: left – 30 mm, right – 15 mm, top and bottom – 20 mm, typed in Microsoft Word.

2. All text of the article, References, summaries, etc. are typed using Times New Roman, size –14, line spacing – 1,5.

3. If the article contains tables and / or figures, they should be compact, have a title, text font – Times New Roman, size – 12. Tables and figures should be no wider than the page width.
